**ORDINANCE NO. 2004 - 03**

**AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL JURISDICTION AND DUTIES OF  
THE TOWN CONSTABLE**

Pursuant to Section 60.22(4), Wis. Stat., and Section 60.35(1), Wis. Stat., the Town Board of the Town of Schleswig hereby adopts this ordinance to add to the jurisdiction and duties of the Town Constable and do ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1. DUTIES.** The Town Constable of the Town of Schleswig, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, shall have, in addition to all existing jurisdiction and duties, the following: To enforce all regulations on behalf of the Town of Schleswig pertaining to personal watercraft as defined in Section 30.50, Wis. Stat., and incorporated in Chapter 20 of the ordinances of the Town of Schleswig. Such authority includes, but is not limited to, directing and regulating traffic and making arrests for violation of the applicable regulations.

**SECTION 2. NONEXCLUSIVITY.**

A. **Other Ordinance.** Adoption of this Ordinance does not preclude the Town Board from adopting any other ordinance or providing for the enforcement of any other law or ordinance relating to the same or other matter.

B. **Other Remedies.** The jurisdiction and duties of the Town Constable as stated herein shall not preclude the Town Board or any other town officer from proceeding under any ordinance or law or by any other enforcement method to enforce any ordinance, regulation, or order.

**SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional as determined by a court of competent jurisdiction, such finding shall not affect

the provisions of this Ordinance which shall be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect on March 11, 2004.
