## TOWN OF SCHLESWIG MANITOWOC COUNTY, WISCONSIN

## Ordinance No. 2015 – 01 Provisional retail licenses.

The provisions of Wis. Stats. § 125.185 apply. A provisional retail license may be approved by the Town Clerk to a person who has applied for a Class "A," Class "B," "Class A," "Class B," or "Class C" license under the following conditions:

- (a) The provisional license authorizes only the activities that the type of retail license applied for authorizes.
- (b) The provisional license expires 60 days after its issuance or when the retail license applied for is issued to the holder, whichever is sooner. The Town of Schleswig Board may revoke the license if the Town of Schleswig Board or Town Clerk discovers that the applicant made a false statement on the application.
- (c) The Town Clerk may not issue a retail "Class B" license if the Town's quota under Wis. Stats. § 125.51(4) prohibits the Town Clerk from issuing a "Class B" license.
- (d) No person may hold more than one provisional retail license for each type of license applied for per year.
- (e) The Town Clerk may only approve the provisional retail license if the background check is completed and the applicant qualifies to receive the retail license applied for.
- (f) The fee for a provisional retail license is \$15 which is payable at the time of application.

This ordinance becomes effective upon passage and publication. Passed this 1st day of December 2015.
