

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING HOLDING TANKS

WHEREAS, Chapter H63 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, relating to private sewage systems provides that the use of holding tank installations will be considered on an individual basis by the Wisconsin Department of Industry, Labor & Human Relations, and

WHEREAS, The State considers holding tank installations as a "system of last resort" due in part to the high individual cost of proper maintenance including pumping of such tanks and the high state-wide incidence of holding tank failures or violative practices, and

WHEREAS, Section H63.18 (2) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code provides that, "Local government may deny the use of holding tanks to serve new construction within their jurisdiction by passing an ordinance prohibiting their use to serve new construction." now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Schleswig Town Board that holding tanks installed to serve new construction within the boundaries of the Town of Schleswig is prohibited.
