

TOWN OF SCHLESWIG

Building Permit Ordinance #84.2

- A. Requirement. No new construction or remodeling in excess of a TOTAL Amount of \$500.00 shall commence hereafter within the Town of Schleswig or ground broken for the same, until a permit therefore shall first have been obtained from the Building Permit Administrator by the owner, or his authorized agent. The term "building" as used in this section shall include any building or structure, and any enlargement, alteration, improvement, electrical, heating, plumbing, or ventilating installation, moving or demolishing, or anything affecting the fire hazards or safety of any building or structure.
- B. Application. Application for a building permit shall be made to the Building Permit Administrator at the monthly Town Meeting and shall contain such other information as the Building Permit Administrator may require for effective enforcement of this ordinance. Special permission to commence construction or remodeling before a formal permit is issued may be obtained from the Building Permit Administrator.
- C. Fees. The fee for a building permit shall be One Dollar (\$1.00)
- D. Permit Lapses. A building permit shall lapse and be void unless operations under the permit are commenced within one year from the date of issuance thereof.
- E. Penalty. Any person failing to obtain a building permit will be assessed a Fifty Dollar (\$50.00) fine by the Town Board. Enforcement to begin on February 1, 1984.

F. Abrogation. It is not intended by this Ordinance to repeal, abrogate, annul, impair, or interfere with any existing local, county or state ordinances, rules, regulations, or permits previously adopted or issued pursuant to law.
