ORDINANCE NO. 94-1

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH JURISDICTION AND DUTIES
OF TOWN CONSTABLE

The Town Board of the Town of Schleswig, Manitowoc County, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Statutory Authority. Pursuant to Section 60.22(4) and Section 60.36, Wis. Stat., the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Schleswig, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, hereby establishes the jurisdiction, duties, and specific authority of the Town Constable of the Town of Schleswig, Manitowoc County.

Section 2. Jurisdiction and Duties. The Town Constable of the Town of Schleswig, Manitowoc County, shall carry out the following duties:

2.1 Cause to be enforced and prosecuted all violations of Town Ordinances of which the Constable has knowledge or information.

2.2 Act on behalf of the Town Board as directed for the peace and order of the Town.

Section 3. Firearms. The Constable is authorized to carry and to use a handgun or shotgun personally owned by the Constable in the course of enforcing Town Ordinance 10.03(8), and responding to a complaint or situation of dogs or other animals running at large in the Town. This authority shall be exercised by the Constable reasonably under the circumstances for securing and maintaining the public peace, health and safety.

Section 4. Nonexclusive.

This Ordinance is not exclusive. The Town Board reserves the right to adopt other ordinances for enforcement. The jurisdiction and duties of the Town Constable stated herein shall not preclude the Town Board or any other Town officer from proceeding under any ordinance or law by any other enforcement method to enforce the ordinance, regulation, or order.

Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional as determined by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the provisions or applications of this Ordinance which shall be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and posting as required by law.

The foregoing Ordinance was adopted at a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Schleswig on 10 Nov, 1994.
