ORDINANCE NO. 2001-02

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS,
ORDINANCE NO. 1997-01**

The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Schleswig, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, pursuant to its authority under Section 81.01, Wis. Stat., hereby amends Ordinance No. 1997-01, Highway Construction Standards, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3.3 is amended to provide as follows:

3.3 The base course shall be constructed with a base layer of 9 inches of material including, but not limited to, heavy course stone, 2 inch to 4 inch crushed rock, road gravel (3/4 inch gravel) of a quality, thickness, and composition suitable for the location. The surface course shall be constructed with a base cover of 9 inches of crushed gravel aggregate and 2½ inches of compacted bituminous blacktop surface. The shoulder shall be crushed gravel.

SECTION 2. Section 5 is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

SECTION 5. FINAL INSPECTION AND CONVEYANCE. Upon completion of the proposed highway, the Town Board shall inspect the proposed highway. The Town Board shall accept or reject the highway in its discretion, based on the applicable standards. If the highway is rejected, the Town Board shall notify the owner of the reasons for the rejection. The owner shall then take necessary steps to remedy the conditions causing the rejection. The owner shall then notify the Town Board, and the Town Board shall proceed with another inspection. When the Town Board notifies the owner of acceptance of the highway, the owner thereof shall deliver to the Town Board in recordable form a warranty deed conveying the highway to the Town, free and clear of all encumbrances. The transfer may also be accomplished by legal dedication to the Town on a final plat recorded according to Chapter 236, Wis. Stat.

SECTION 3. Except has herein modified, the terms of Ordinance No. 1997-01 are hereby ratified and confirmed.
