Ordinance No. 2014 – 01

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING ALL-TERAIN VEHICLE ROUTES AND REGULATING THE OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES

Section 1 – Intent

The Town of Schleswig, Manitowoc County adopts the following all-terrain vehicle route for the operation of all-terrain vehicles upon the roadways listed in Section 3.

Following due consideration of the recreational value to connect trail opportunities and weighted against possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, terrain involved, traffic density and history of automobile traffic, this route has been created.

Section 2 – Statutory Authority

This route is created pursuant to Town authority under section 1.1.01 as authorized by 23.33(8)(b) Wis. Stats

The applicable provisions of 23.33 regulating ATV operation pursuant to routes are adopted.

Section 3 – Routes

All town roads are designated as routes.

Section 4 – Conditions

As a condition for the use of these routes, the following conditions shall apply to all operators (and passengers):

- A. All ATV operators shall observe posted roadway speed limits.
- B. All ATV operators shall ride single file.
- C. Routes must be signed in accordance with NR 64.12 and NR 64.12(7)c.

Section 5- Enforcement

This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

Section 6 – Penalties

Wisconsin state All-Terrain Vehicle penalties as found in 23.33 (13)(a) Wis. Stats. are adopted by reference.

Section 7 – Severability

The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstance is held invalid. The remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons circumstances shall nor be deemed affected.

Section 8 – Effective Date

This ordinance becomes effective upon passage and publication. Passed this 13th day of March 2014.
