AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE  
PROHIBITION AND REGULATION OF NOISE" Ordinance No. 2004-02

The Town Board of Schleswig, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, hereby amends Ordinance No. 2004-02, "An ordinance to provide for the prohibition and regulation of noise" as follows;

**Section #2 – (3) amended to provide as follows;**

No permit shall be granted hereunder for use between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. unless granted prior approval of the Board.

**Section #2 – (6) amended to provide as follows;**

Each day of an event requires a permit.

**Section #2 – (7) amended to provide as follows;**

The fee will typically be waived but may be reviewed from time to time and adjusted by resolution.

*Except as herein modified, the terms of Ordinance No. 2004-02 are hereby ratified and confirmed.*

**ORDINANCE NO. 2004- 02**

**AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROHIBITION  
AND REGULATION OF NOISE**

The Town Board of the Town of Schleswig, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, pursuant to its village powers under Section 60.10(2)(c) and Section 60.22(3), Wis. Stat., in order to provide for the public health, safety, and welfare, do ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF NOISES DISTURBING THE PUBLIC PEACE.**

(1) It shall be unlawful for any person to make or assist in making any noise tending to unreasonably disturb the comfort or peace and quiet of persons or tending to cause or provoke a disturbance unless the making and continuing of said noise (a) cannot be prevented and (b) is necessary for the protection or preservation of property or of the public health and safety, or that of one or more persons.

(2) It shall be unlawful for any person occupying or having charge of any building, or any premises outside a building, or any part thereof, to cause, suffer, or allow any loud, excessive, or unusual noise in the operation or use of any loud speaker, sound amplifier, or other electronic, mechanical, or electrical sound amplifier system when the loud, excessive, or unusual noise tends to cause or provoke a disturbance or tends to unreasonably disturb the comfort or peace and quiet of persons.

(2) "Person" means any individual, partnership, corporation, limited liability company, government, or any other entity.

SECTION 4. PENALTY. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance, or any regulation, rule, or order made hereunder, or any term of a permit issued hereunder, shall be subject to a penalty of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for the first offense and a penalty of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for the second and each successive offense, together with statutory court costs and costs of prosecution.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. In the event any portion thereof is found to be void or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portions thereof shall remain in full force and effect.
